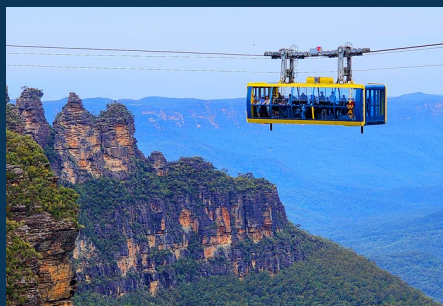

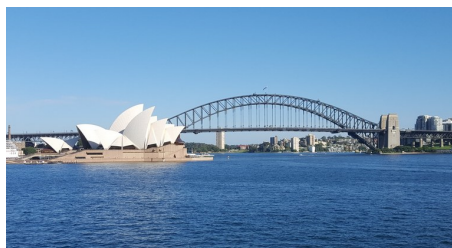

DAY 1

Airport Pick-Up & Sydney Highlights

Full day or 5 hours

We meet you at the airport and drive straight into the city — hotel check-in is only from 2 pm and there is no reason to lose half a day in a lobby. Opera House and Harbour Bridge, the historic Rocks, the Royal Botanic Garden, Mrs Macquarie's Chair, Bondi and Watsons Bay.

A shorter version of the same day is available — 5 hours instead of a full day.

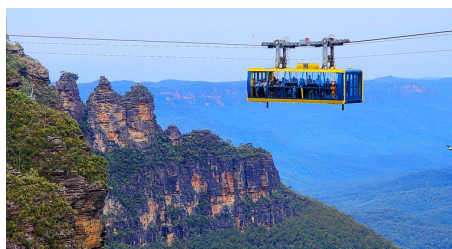

Blue Mountains

Full day

Mountains, canyons, waterfalls and sweeping views: the Three Sisters, the lookouts of Katoomba and Leura, the old mountain villages. Optional Scenic World railway and cableway, plus Featherdale Wildlife Park with hand-feeding kangaroos and koalas.

Entry tickets are extra: wildlife park A\$49 per person · Scenic World A\$70 per person.

South Coast

Full day

Giant rainforest trees and waterfalls at Minnamurra, the serene Nan Tien Buddhist Temple, the Grand Pacific Drive with the Sea Cliff Bridge, the Kiama Blowhole and vast ocean panoramas from the escarpment lookouts.

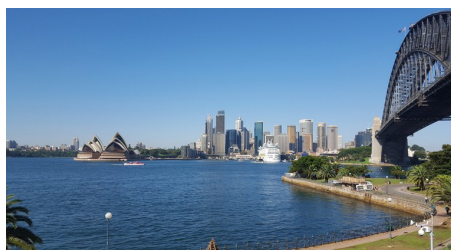

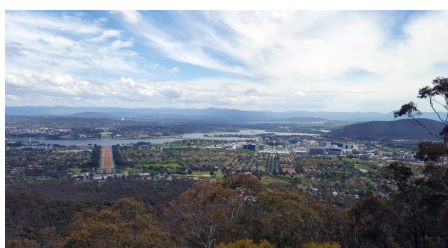

**DAY 5****Canberra — the National Capital**

Full day · optional

Parliament House and its debating chambers, the Australian War Memorial, the national museums and galleries, and the panorama over the planned city from Mount Ainslie. This day costs more — it is around 650 km of driving, almost all on motorways.

**DAY 6****Hunter Valley Wine Tour**

Full day · optional

Tastings at four boutique wineries hosted by the winemakers themselves, local cheese and chocolate, the reptile park on the way, and our secret spots where mobs of wild kangaroos graze right between the vines.

Tastings are included. Reptile park entry is extra if you want koala photos and kangaroo feeding.

**DAY 7****Jervis Bay — the Whitest Sand on Earth**

11 hours · optional

Hyams Beach, recorded as having the whitest sand in the world, wild kangaroos right on the shore and a dolphin cruise across the bay. From June to October it is whale season: in the protected waters of the marine park they come close to small boats.

Cruise tickets are extra: whales A\$85 per person (June–October), dolphins A\$65 per person.
